

Romans 10:14-15 - The Necessities of the Beautiful Message.

- I. Jesus' Gospel Requires Necessary Components - Romans 10:14-15a.
 - A. The Unbelievers' Responses Reveals the Message of Compassion for the World - Ro 10:14abc.
 1. God says it's necessary for unbelievers to **call** with fiduciary commitment to the Jesus of the gospel message - 10:14a.
 2. God says it's necessary for unbelievers to **believe** the facts are true of Jesus' gospel message - 10:14b.
 3. God says it's necessary for unbelievers to **hear** the facts of Jesus' gospel message - 10:14c. **Point:** hearing the preacher is actually hearing Jesus.
 - B. The Believers' Responsibilities Reveals the Method of Crisis for the Church - Ro 10:14d-15a.
 1. God's says it's necessary for the believing messengers to speak Jesus' gospel message: **preach** - 10:14d.
 - a. Proclaiming the Word is the ordinary means of reaching people.
 2. God says it's necessary for the believing ministry to send Jesus' gospel messengers: **send** - 10:15a.

 - B. Jesus & His gospel's ministers proclaim.
 - C. Jesus & His gospel are messages of good news.
