 - A. The Unbelievers' Responses Reveals the Message of Compassion for the World Ro 10:14abc.
 - 1. God says it's necessary for unbelievers to <u>call</u> with fiduciary commitment to the Jesus of the gospel message 10:14a.
 - 2. God says it's necessary for unbelievers to **believe** the facts are true of Jesus' gospel message 10:14b.
 - God says it's necessary for unbelievers to <u>hear</u> the facts of Jesus' gospel message - 10:14c. <u>Point</u>: hearing the preacher is actually hearing Jesus.
 - B. The Believers' Responsibilities Reveals the Method of Crisis for the Church Ro 10:14d-15a.
 - God says it's necessary for the believing messengers to speak Jesus' gospel message: <u>preach</u> - 10:14d.
 - a. Proclaiming the Word is the ordinary means of reaching people.
 - God says it's necessary for the believing ministry to send Jesus' gospel messengers: <u>send</u> - 10:15a.
