- II. Second Excuse: "Israel Didn't Understand." Answer: "All Understood, & Gentiles Get the Gospel" - Romans 10:19-20.
  - A. Kinds of Ignorance.
    - 1. Lacking facts.
    - 2. Neglecting knowledge.
    - 3. Willful blindness.
  - B. See God's grace in reaching Gentiles (De 32:21; Is 65:1-2).
    - 1. Gentiles are not a nation, unlike Israel.
    - 2. Gentiles have no understanding, unlike Israel.
    - 3. Gentiles do not seek God, unlike Israel.
- III. Despite Excuses, God Yearns for His People Romans 10:21.
  - A. See God's great goodness of compassionate patience toward people Ro 10:21a.
    - 1. Continuous, persistent initiation all day long.
    - 2. Compassionate, patient invitation stretched out to.
    - 3. Costly, personal involvement My hands.
  - B. See peoples' great badness of passionate unbelief toward God
    Ro 10:21b.
    - 1. Disobedient.
    - 2. Obstinate.

Conclusion: Mat 11:28-30 - God still is holding out His hands toward people who are: 1) religion-ruined; 2) rebellion-running; & 3) resource-reduced.
